HOW TO GET THERE

The National Exhibition Centre Arena is at the heart of the UK's transport network, with good access by road, rail and air from all areas.

By rail: The NEC Arena is served by Birmingham International station, connected by a covered bridgelink. For train times and booking information telephone 08457 484950 or visit www.nationalrail.co.uk

By car: Birmingham NEC is at the hub of the UK motorway network, enabling easy access from the M6, M1, M42 and M40. The NEC has its own on-site car parks (for which there is a £6 car and £15 coach parking charge for the day).

Follow signs for Trumpet Call to find the closest parking to the NEC Arena.

By public service coach: National Express operate services to Birmingham International Airport, which is adjacent to the NEC. For coach times and bookings telephone 08705 808080 or visit www.nationalexpress.com

By air: Birmingham International Airport is situated a few minutes from the NEC Arena, and linked by monorail. Flights are available from several UK regional airports. Contact your local airport or travel agent for details, or visit www.bhx.co.uk (the Birmingham International Airport website)
